<p><b>Schedule</b></p> <p><b>Art work accepted</b> Saturday, May 7 10:30 am to 3 pm</p> <p><b>Opening Reception</b> Friday, May 13 5 to 7:30 pm</p> <p><b>Exhibit Open</b> May 13 - June 4</p> <p><b>Art picked up</b> Saturday, June 4 10:30 am to 2 pm</p> <p><b>Location</b> Public Library 153 West Main Street Romney, WV 26757</p>	<p><b>Eligibility</b></p> <p>The 2016 Spring Fine Arts Show is open to all U.S. artists age 18 and older. All works must be original, and completed on or later than October 1, 2013.</p> <p>Entries in the following media will be accepted: painting, watercolor, drawing, mixed media, printmaking, ceramics, sculpture, carving, textile, glass, wood, metal work, photography.</p> <p>Two-dimensional work must not exceed 3' in width &amp; 3' in height, and must be ready for exhibition and ready to hang by wire. We are not able to accept work that requires suspension from the ceiling. Textiles may be larger if they can be folded for display. Work to be hung must not be over 20 pounds.</p> <p>Three-dimensional work must not exceed 5 feet in any direction or weigh more than 100 pounds. Depending on size, they will be placed on pedestals or on the floor for display.</p> <p>All work must be labeled with the artist's name, title, short description, &amp; price.</p>	<p><b>Insurance</b></p> <p>Each artist is responsible for the insurance of their art. Neither HCAC nor the Library assumes any responsibility</p> <p><b>Sales</b></p> <p>Sales are encouraged and all works are assumed to be available for purchase unless designated "Not For Sale" (NFS).</p> <p>Neither HCAC nor the Library will act for the artist in the sale, so the artist should provide information for any potential buyers to contact them for the transaction. (Note: items are to remain in the Show until June 4.)</p> <p>A 20% commission is to be paid to the HCAC by the artist for each sale by June 14, 2016. Commission checks should be mailed to HCAC, PO Box 624, Romney, WV 26757.</p> <p><b>Judge</b></p> <p>Susan Williamson is the Visual Arts Coordinator of the Carroll Arts Center in Westminster, MD, and an artist and lecturer in Art History. She is the former owner of Off the Wall Pottery in Easton, MD, and the founder of Off Track Art, an artists' coop in downtown Westminster.</p>
<p><b>Awards</b></p> <p><b>Best in Show - \$250</b> <b>2nd Place - \$125</b> <b>(Vincent Melzac Memorial Award)</b> <b>3rd Place - \$75</b> <b>Honorable Mentions</b></p> <p>Awards will be presented at the Opening Reception</p>	<p>The HCAC screening/registration panel will serve as the final authority on eligibility.</p> <p>All art is expected to be displayed throughout the length of the Fine Arts Show.</p> <p>We recommend work submitted should be considered for general viewing audiences of all ages.</p> <p><b>Fee, Entry, &amp; Pick-up Procedure</b></p> <p>The fee for HCAC members is \$20 and non-HCAC members is \$30. The Fee allows each artist to enter up to three works.</p> <p>All items must be brought to the Hampshire County Public Library, Romney, WV, Saturday, May 7, between 10:30 am and 3 pm.</p>	<p>In her role as Visual Arts Coordinator, Susan curates three galleries, organizes art classes, bus trips, and assists in the organization of indoor and outdoor art festivals.</p> <p>Susan has juried exhibits at the Howard County Arts Council, Allegany Arts Council, the Delaplaine, as well as the Hanover Artists Guild, Carroll Camera Club, and various high school and youth art events. She is interested in creating exhibits that are reflective of a variety of media. This creates a beautiful depth for the viewers of the exhibits.</p>
